

Huntsville Elementary School Basic Supply List

- Bookbags without rollers (Rolling book bags create space and safety issues.)
- Pencil pouch with zipper (with or without notebook holes) or pencil box.
- Jumbo/Chubby pencils
- Scissors (child sized with blunt tip & regular size) Fiskars brand hold up best
- Glue sticks
- Pack of 8 large crayons (Crayola work best and last longer)
- Packs of 24 small crayons (Crayola work best and last longer)
- Two-pocket folders without fasteners
- Dry erase markers (Expo brand work best)
- Dry erase board erasers
- #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) (Ticonderoga last longer)
- Two-subject spiral notebooks (wide ruled)
- One subject marble composition (not spiral bound) notebooks (wide ruled)
- Two pocket plastic folders with prongs/clasps (red, green, yellow, orange, purple or blue)
- Three ring binders (one inch size)
- Packs of wide ruled filler paper
- Erasers (pencil top, stick or block)
- Color pencils
- Washable markers
- Clear sheet protectors
- Clipboards
- Electric pencil sharpener
- Copier paper (any color)
- Ink pens (blue, black, or red ink)
- Elmer's glue
- Highlighters (Yellow only)
- Tabbed notebook dividers
- Headphones or ear buds (inexpensive type)
- 3x3 post-it notes
- Construction paper
- Index cards
- Boxes of tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Snack, pint, quart and gallon size Ziplock bags
- Bottles of antibacterial soap
- Packs of magic erasers
- Lysol Spray
- Paper towels
- Antibacterial wipes
- Chorox wipes
- Mat or towel for brief rest time (Kindergarten)
- Baby wipes, bar soap, band-aids
- Treasure chest items (small toys, decorative pencils, coloring books, puzzles, etc.
